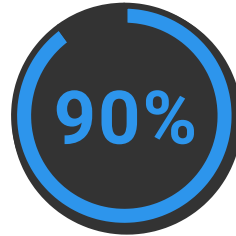

Insulin, Glucose and A1C are typical tests ordered by your doctor to assess how well your body is transporting and processing sugar in your bloodstream.

Microalbumin is a test for small (micro) amounts of a protein called albumin in your urine which results from damage to your kidneys. Both diabetes and high blood pressure can result in kidney damage.

Adiponectin is a hormone that plays a crucial role in protecting against insulin resistance and diabetes and atherosclerosis. Decreased adiponectin levels are associated with higher risk for obesity, diabetes and cardiovascular disease.
